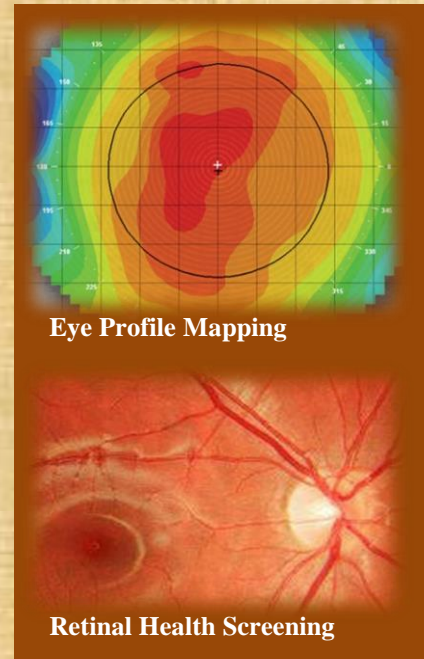
"The treatment is fully reversible and helps to control your myopia", says **Andy Teo** and the therapy can be applied to both children and adult who wants freedom from wearing glasses.
